Located in West Asia, Yemen 's environmental issues involve mainly water scarcity, environmental pollution, and climate change. However, UNDP reported in 2023 that years of humanitarian and development crises undermine socio-economic development and worsen environmental. Yemen stands as one of the most climate-vulnerable nations globally, a reality further compounded by conflict, erratic rainfall patterns, and extreme weather events, including devastating floods. In December 2024, the European Institute of Peace concluded a series of unilateral meetings to discuss the status of environmental governance in Yemen and explore potential pathways for environmental dialogue and cooperation with technical and political representatives of the Ministry of Water and. Yemeni society is worried about how climate change is impacting their lives, and a majority considers it essential to consider environmental challenges in national peace efforts. 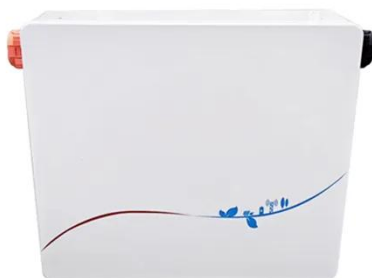
