The Gambia has officially opened a 23 MW solar power facility with 8 MWh of battery storage. This project is part of the Gambia Power Restoration and Modernization Project (GERMP), which aims to provide universal access to power by 2025. The power station began commercial operations in March 2024. It is owned and was developed by the government of Gambia, with funding from the European Union, the European Investment Bank and the. The Gambia entered a new era of energy development in April 2023 with the inauguration of its first large-scale solar energy facility in Jambur.

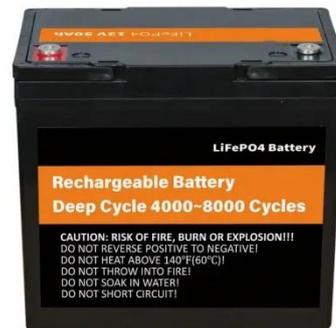


